Floreat Fives and Fours.

This year, in addition to the Quintet (3 pipers, a bass drummer and a snare drummer) and Quartet (4 pipers) components of our contest, we are adding a **Floreat Freestyle** event where bands can add any other instruments to their performance (guitars, strings, percussion etc).

The small band format changes the dynamic, allowing bands to field multiple teams, and potentially play up a grade to introduce some entertaining competition.

The Floreat Fives format.

Quintets of 3 pipers, 1 bass, 1 snare. Medleys for Grade 1, 2, 3, 4a, 4b and Juvenile. Selection of Marches for Grades 4b and Juvenile.

The Floreat Fours format.

Quartets of 4 pipers. Medleys for Grade 1, 2, 3, 4a, 4b and Juvenile. Selection of Marches for Grades 4 and Juvenile.

Floreat Freestyle format.

Play with 6 or less musicians, comprising at least 33% pipe band instruments (for example, 1 tenor drum, 1 guitar, 1 fiddle – or 2x bagpipes with 1 bongo drum and 1 tenor drum).

Think of the possibilities:

- Enter 2 or more teams in your grade and motivate excellence through friendly rivalry.
- Have 1 team try out a new medley while another plays the tried-and-true one.
- Have your best players "play up a grade" and give the guys above you a scare.

• New quartet and quintet rules change who you can play with... you don't have to be a registered band, you just need to have registered individuals in you group. Read more <u>here</u>

Fun & friendly setting.

The venue is a raised outdoor stage area at the Cambridge Scout Hall, with a backdrop of shady Perry Lakes parkland. Spectators form an L shape and are closer to the bands than regular contests. There will be haggis burgers, sausage sizzle, coffees, soft drinks and bar service.

- Players of a group shall be Members of the Association (Pipe Bands WA) but are not required to be registered with the same band.
- Quintet (3 Pipers, 1 Bass, 1 Snare). Pipe Major, lead snare and/or lead bass permitted to play in more than one team under rule C. Tune requirements as stated in Part B.4.01 under Pipe Bands Australia Inc. contest rules
- **Quartet** (4 Pipers). Pipe Major permitted to play in more than one team under rule C. Tune requirements as stated in Part B.4.01 under <u>Pipe Bands Australia Inc. contest rules</u>
- **Freestyle** (6 or less musicians). This is an open component, and players need not be registered. Rules and guidelines detailed on Page 5.
- The promoter reserves the right to cancel any event if insufficient entries.
- Entries close 6pm on 17 March 2024.
- Entry fee to be paid at contest prior to performing. Please find Announcer Desk for payment.
- Entries received after the due date may be accepted, but subject to a \$10 late entry fee.
- By sending in an entry, the band agrees to be liable for payment.
- All decisions made by the Contest Supervisor are final.

A new competition category!

Aim: To provide a platform where the focus is to generate fun and encourage musical creativity that pushes the boundaries of a traditional pipe band contest.

RULES AND GUIDELINES

- Teams with a maximum limit of six musicians.
- At least 33% traditional pipe band instruments must be included (so one third of the total instruments should be either a highland bagpipe, bass drum, tenor drum or snare drum), but can be accompanied by any other musical instruments.
- 3 minutes minimum and 6 minutes maximum time limit for the set.
- No restrictions on the type of music (rock, classical, folk etc).
- No need to commence the set with 3-paced rolls.
- Competitors are not required to be registered members of Pipe Bands Australia and are not restricted to wearing traditional highland dress.
- Judging will be by a panel and will take into account audience appeal and entertainment.
